The Jewish Women's Foundation of San Diego is dedicated to supporting the Jewish community through innovative and creative funding to benefit and enhance the lives of primarily Jewish women and girls locally, nationally and globally.

Guided by Jewish values, the Jewish Women's Foundation (JWF) creates awareness of the issues and needs of Jewish women and girls. Women are empowered as funders, decision makers, and agents for community change.

Since 2004, the JWF has granted and leveraged more than \$700,000 to address critical issues facing Jewish women and girls. The 2014-2017 grantee programs include:

JEWISH FAMILY SERVICE

Jewish Family Service will expand its existing services, such as its *Bikkur Holim* Friendly Visitor Program, increase Sunday transportation, and lunch and entertainment at its College Avenue Center. JFS will also partner with teens through The Friendship Circle and provide technology education to the senior women. Program outreach will be focused in eastern San Diego.

LAWRENCE FAMILY JEWISH COMMUNITY CENTER, JACOBS FAMILY CAMPUS

The JCC will invite participants to a variety of topics, clubs, Jewish holiday celebrations, and outings. Women who are already active in the JCC programs will host newcomers for afternoon teas and Shabbat dinners, and serve as ambassadors to welcome the new women when they attend JCC activities. The JCC will also offer technology tutoring with teens for the seniors to keep in touch with their grandchildren, and also mentor the teen volunteers.

JWF Grant Initiative
