- Professional video about their project

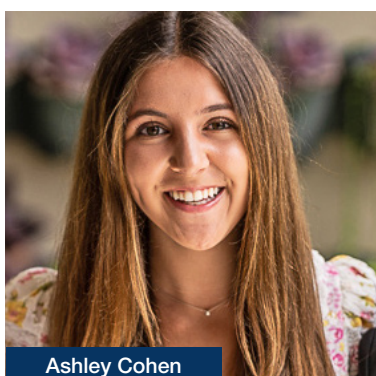

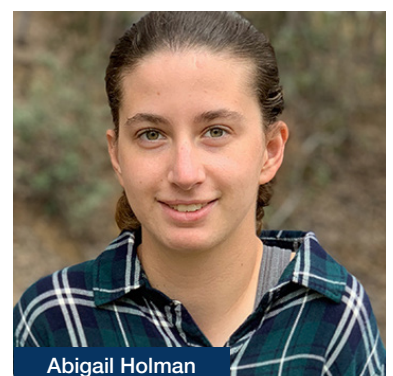
