



## OPTION A: Interest Area

Under Option A, organizations are working to address one of the following areas of interest in San Diego.

### ❖ Choose ONE interest area.

- Seniors
- The Environment
- Youth - Food insecurity and Nutrition
- Youth - Homeless housing for youth up to 25 years old

### ❖ Guidelines:

- **Awards may be up to \$150,000 each.** Requests should be no less than \$50,000.
- Applicants may apply for a multi-year grant with clear, measurable impact metrics.
- Organizations with annual budgets of UNDER \$2MM are eligible.
