OPTION B: Collaborative Initiative

Under Option B, organizations are working together to address a cause or issue in San Diego. Their impact is achieved through intentional collaboration and partnership.

Guidelines:

- **Awards may be up to \$150,000 each**
- Applicants must currently be collaborating with at least one other agency or propose a new collaborative initiative.
- Applicants may apply for a multi-year grant with clear, measurable impact metrics.
- Applicants must apply as a single, unified project or program (“apply as one”).
- No budget constraints or limits.

Schedule: organizations must be available on the following dates.
